Luke 5:27-32 – I encourage you to pray for more relationships with the least, the last, and the lost! Jesus sought out those in need of a doctor. We are surrounded by neighbors, classmates, and coworkers, even some in this building on Sundays! Pray to see them how Jesus sees them.

Luke 6:20-26 – Pray that you can value these same things in yourself. Humility, gentleness, generosity, living in a way that draws persecution. And that God removes the things we value that are lesser – riches and being well fed.

Matthew 9:35-38 – Pray that in whatever way God may be leading you to participate in the harvest, you can step into it with joy. Pray for the right connection for Sunday Lunch this week that can lead to follow-up small groups, discipleship, and connections to the least, the last, and the lost.
